1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Publications Ordinance. Short title.

2. In this Ordinance, unless the context otherwise requires, the term "book" includes every volume, part, or division of a volume, and pamphlet in any language, and every sheet of music, map, chart, or plan separately printed or lithographed; but shall not include any publication which consists merely of a price list, sale catalogue, annual report, trade circular, or trade advertisement. Interpreta-
tion.

3. Three printed or lithographed copies of the whole of every book which shall be printed or lithographed in this Colony, together with all maps, prints, or other engravings belonging thereto, finished and coloured in the same manner as the best copies of the same, shall be produced, and also of any second, or subsequent, edition which shall be so produced, with any additions or alterations, whether the same shall be in letterpress, Delivery to
