## ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

1. Short title

### **Short title**

1. This Act is the Explosive Substances Act 1924.

### **Interpretation**

2. In this Act, “explosive substance” shall be deemed to include —
  - (a) any material for making any explosive substance; and
  - (b) any apparatus, machine, implement or material used, or intended to be used, or adapted for causing, or aiding in causing, any explosion in or with any explosive substance, and any part of any such apparatus, machine or implement.
