In exercise of the powers conferred by section 6(3) of the Diplomatic and Consular Relations Act, the Minister for Foreign Affairs hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Diplomatic and Consular Relations (Commonwealth Secretariat) Order 2008 and shall come into operation on 1st June 2008.

Definitions

- 2. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires
 - "Commonwealth" means the association of sovereign states known as the Commonwealth of Nations, and includes the Commonwealth Secretariat;
