Citation

1. This Notification may be cited as the Immigration Anchorages Notification.

Definitions

2. In this Notification —

“fishing vessel” has the same meaning as in the Fisheries Act (Cap. 111);

“passenger ferry” means a vessel which carries passengers from regional ports to Singapore and vice versa;

“passenger vessel” means a vessel which has —

(a) a definite and fixed estimated time of arrival and estimated time of departure; and

(b) accommodation cabins for passengers;

“pleasure craft” has the same meaning as in the Maritime and Port Authority of Singapore (Pleasure Craft) Regulations (Cap. 170A, Rg 6);

“yacht” means a vessel which is used exclusively for pleasure purposes and for the use of which a passenger, if any, is not charged a separate and distinct fare.

Anchorage

3. The Anchorages set out in the first column of the Schedule are hereby declared to be Immigration Anchorages for the purposes specified against them in the second column thereof.

7. Tanah Merah Ferry Terminal For passenger ferries arriving in or are about to leave Singapore.
8. The International Passenger Terminal and Regional Ferry Terminal at the Singapore Cruise Centre For passenger ferries and passenger vessels arriving in or are about to leave Singapore.

15. Marina Bay Cruise Centre Singapore For passenger vessels arriving in or are about to leave Singapore.
16. Sudong Petroleum Holding Anchorage For vessels arriving in or about to leave Singapore, other than passenger ferries, passenger vessels, pleasure craft and yachts.
17. Sudong Explosive Anchorage For vessels arriving in or about to leave Singapore, other than passenger ferries, passenger vessels,
