In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 8(1) and 13(1) of the Infrastructure Protection Act 2017, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

#### Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Infrastructure Protection (Protected Areas) (No. 2) Order 2021 and comes into operation on 8 April 2021.

## Premises declared to be protected area

2. The premises described in the second column of the Schedule are declared to be a protected area for the purposes of the Act, and the person specified in the first column of

that Schedule is designated as the authority of the protected area.

**3.** The Protected Areas Order 2016 (G.N. No. S 126/2016) is revoked.
