LIQUOR CONTROL (SUPPLY AND CONSUMPTION) (DECLARATION OF LIQUOR CONTROL ZONES) ORDER 2015

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15(1) of the Liquor Control (Supply and Consumption) Act 2015, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Liquor Control (Supply and Consumption) (Declaration of Liquor Control Zones) Order 2015 and comes into operation on 1 April 2015.

- **2.** The following areas are declared to be Liquor Control Zones under section 15(1) of the Act with effect from 1 April 2015:
 - (a) the area known as Geylang as described in Part 1 of the Schedule;
 - (b) the area known as Little India as described in Part 2 of the Schedule.



PART 1 — GEYLANG

All that area the boundary of which starts at the junction of Sims Avenue and Paya Lebar Road and continues progressively —

- (a) generally south-west along Paya Lebar Road until its junction with Geylang Road;
- (b) generally south-west along Guillemard Road until its junction with Sims Way;
- (c) generally north along Sims Way past its junction with Geylang Road until its junction with Sims Avenue; and
- (d) generally north-east along Sims Avenue to the point where the boundary begins, and which is more particularly demarcated in the map below.



PART 2 — LITTLE INDIA

All that area the boundary of which starts at the junction of Jalan Besar and Petain Road and continues progressively —

(a) generally north-west along Petain Road, past its junction with Somme Road until its junction with Sturdee Road;
