MOTOR VEHICLES (THIRD-PARTY RISKS AND COMPENSATION) (EXEMPTION OF POWER-ASSISTED BICYCLES) NOTIFICATION 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Motor Vehicles (Third-Party Risks and Compensation) Act, the Minister for Transport hereby makes the following Notification:

Citation and commencement

1. This Notification may be cited as the Motor Vehicles (Third-Party Risks and Compensation) (Exemption of Power-Assisted Bicycles) Notification 2004 and shall come into operation on 1st January 2005.

Definition

2. In this Notification, “power-assisted bicycle” means a bicycle that is equipped with an electric motor and that may be propelled by muscular power or by the electric motor with which it is equipped, or by both.
