## **MUTUAL BENEFIT ORGANISATIONS ACT (CHAPTER 191)**

### **MUTUAL BENEFIT ORGANISATIONS (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2004**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 48(2) of the Mutual Benefit Organisations Act, the Minister for Community Development and Sports hereby makes the following Order:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Mutual Benefit Organisations (Exemption) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on 4th February 2004.

#### **Definition**

**2.** In this Order, “relevant conviction” means a conviction —

- (a) for any offence involving dishonesty or moral turpitude; or
- (b) for any other offence, where the convicted person has been sentenced to a fine of not less than \$2,000 or to imprisonment for a term of not less than one year.
