MUTUAL BENEFIT ORGANISATIONS (EXEMPTION) ORDER 2004

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 48(2) of the Mutual Benefit Organisations Act, the Minister for Community Development and Sports hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Mutual Benefit Organisations (Exemption) Order 2004 and shall come into operation on 4th February 2004.

Definition

- 2. In this Order, "relevant conviction" means a conviction
 - (a) for any offence involving dishonesty or moral turpitude; or
 - (b) for any other offence, where the convicted person has been sentenced to a fine of not less than \$2,000 or to imprisonment for a term of not less than one year.
