# ROAD TRAFFIC ACT 1961

#### ROAD TRAFFIC (NANYANG TECHNOLOGICAL UNIVERSITY — EXEMPTION) ORDER 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act 1961, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

### Citation and period in force

**1.**—(1) This Order is the Road Traffic (Nanyang Technological University — Exemption) Order 2022.

(2) This Order is in force for the period between 20 January 2022 and 30 March 2023 (both dates inclusive).

### Definitions

2. In this Order —

"research project" means the research project known as the Programme for Micro-Mobility Safety and Utility Research undertaken by Nanyang Technological University from 1 December 2020 to 31 May 2023 (both dates inclusive);

"specified personal mobility device" means a personal mobility device that —

- (a) is a registrable personal mobility device registered under Part 3A of the Active Mobility Act 2017;
- (b) is not a non-compliant personal mobility device under the Active Mobility Act 2017; and
- (c) is used by Nanyang Technological University for the purpose of the research project;

"specified road" means any of the roads delineated by a black-coloured line in the maps set out in the Schedule.

#### Exemption for specified personal mobility device riders

**3.** Section 5A of the Act does not apply to any individual who rides a specified personal mobility device on a specified road, for or in connection with the research project, if all of the following conditions are satisfied:

- (*a*) the individual is authorised by Nanyang Technological University to ride the specified personal mobility device;
- (b) no more than 2 specified personal mobility devices are ridden at any time on the specified road.
