An Act to repeal and re-enact with amendments the Pharmacists Registration Act (Chapter 230 of the 1985 Revised Edition), to establish the Singapore Pharmacy Council, to provide for the registration of pharmacists and for matters connected therewith, and to make consequential amendments to certain other written laws.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:
