## **UNITED NATIONS ACT 2001**

(No. 44 of 2001)

### ARRANGEMENT OF SECTIONS

#### Section

- 1. Short title and commencement
- 2. Power to make regulations to enable effect to be given to Article 41 of Charter of United Nations
- 3. Immunity from suit
- 4. Protection of persons for acts done under this Act
- 5. Liability for breach of regulations
- 6. Liability of citizens of Singapore for offences committed outside Singapore
