An Act to amend the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (1992 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

- 1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Amendment) Act 1998 and shall come into operation on such date as the President may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.
- (2) The President may appoint different dates for the coming into operation of the different provisions of this Act.

Amendment of Article 22

2. Article 22(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (referred to in this Act as the Constitution) is amended by deleting paragraph (g) and substituting the following paragraph:
