An Act to amend the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Amendment No. 2) Act 1990 and shall come into operation on such date as the President may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Amendment of Article 103

2. Article 103 of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (referred to in this Act as the Constitution) is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (iv) of the definition of “public office” in paragraph (b) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

- “(i the office of member of the Public Service Commission, the Legal
- v) Service Commission, the Education Service Commission or the Police and Civil Defence Services Commission;”.

Amendment of Article 105

3. Article 105(1) of the Constitution is amended by deleting the words “11 other members” and substituting the words “14 other members”.

New Articles 110A, 110B and 110C

4. The Constitution is amended by inserting, immediately after Article 110, the following Articles:

“Education Service Commission

110A.—(1) There shall be an Education Service Commission which shall consist of —
