NATURE RESERVES (AMENDMENT) ACT 1988

An Act to amend the Nature Reserves Act (Chapter 205 of the Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Nature Reserves (Amendment) Act 1988 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Repeal and re-enactment of section 4

2. Section 4 of the Nature Reserves Act (referred to in this Act as the principal Act) is repealed and the following section substituted therefor:

“Minister may amend nature reserve boundary

4. The Minister may, after consultation with the Board, by order amend the Schedule.”.

New section 7A

3. The principal Act is amended by inserting, immediately after section 7, the following section:

“Nature Reserves Fund

7A.—(1) There shall be established and maintained by the Board a fund to be called the Nature Reserves Fund (referred to in this section as the Fund) into which
