Customs (Amendment) Bill

Read the first time on 1st June 1998.

An Act to amend the Customs Act (Chapter 70 of the 1997 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Customs (Amendment) Act 1998 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

(2) The Minister may appoint different dates for the coming into operation of the different provisions of this Act.

Amendment of section 3

2. Section 3(1) of the Customs Act is amended by deleting the words “, railway station” in the definitions of “Green Channel” and “Red Channel”.

Amendment of section 31

3. Section 31(1) of the Customs Act is amended by deleting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) by rail, at the customs station along the railway; or”.

Amendment of section 34

4. Section 34(1) of the Customs Act is amended —

(a) by deleting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) from the customs station along the railway at which the goods arrived;”; and

(b) by inserting, immediately after the word “Woodlands” in paragraph (d), the words “or Tuas”.

Amendment of section 37

5. Section 37 of the Customs Act is amended —

(a) by deleting paragraph (c) and substituting the following paragraph:
