Singapore Armed Forces (Amendment No. 2) Bill

Read the first time on 25th July 1994.

An Act to amend the Singapore Armed Forces Act (Chapter 295 of the 1985 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Singapore Armed Forces (Amendment No. 2) Act 1994 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Amendment of section 2

2. Section 2(1) of the Singapore Armed Forces Act (referred to in this Act as the principal Act) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after the definition of “national serviceman”, the following definition:

“ “non-uniformed serviceman” means a regular serviceman who is not required under his terms of service to wear military uniform;”;

(b) by inserting, immediately after the definition of “officer”, the following definition:

“ “operationally ready national serviceman” means a person liable to render operationally ready national service under the Enlistment Act [Cap. 93];”;

(c) by deleting the definition of “reservist”.

Amendment of section 3

3. Section 3 of the principal Act is amended by inserting, immediately after the word “shall” in the second line, the words “, subject to such exclusions or variations in relation to non-uniformed servicemen as may be prescribed,”.

Amendment of section 19

4. Section 19 of the principal Act is amended by inserting, immediately after the word
