Road Traffic (Amendment No. 2) Bill

An Act to amend the Road Traffic Act (Chapter 276 of the 1985 Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows:

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment No. 2) Act 1993 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

Amendment of section 2

2. Section 2 of the Road Traffic Act (referred to in this Act as the principal Act) is amended by inserting, immediately after the words “motor vehicle” in the definition of “park”, the words “or a trailer”.

Amendment of section 10A

3. Section 10A of the principal Act is amended —

(a) by deleting subsection (1) and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) No vehicle shall be registered or, except as otherwise provided by this Act or the rules, continue to be registered under this Act unless there is in force a permit issued by the Registrar authorising the registration of the vehicle.”; and

(b) by inserting, immediately after paragraph (h) of subsection (4), the following paragraph:

“(ha) provide for the renewal of a permit before or after its expiration and the levy and any other fee to be paid therefor;”.

New section 10B

4. The principal Act is amended by inserting, immediately after section 10A, the following section:
