An Act to amend certain Statutes of the Republic of Singapore.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows: —

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Statutes of the Republic of Singapore (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No. 2) Act, 1973.

Miscellaneous amendments

2. The provisions of the Acts specified in the first column of the Schedule to this Act are hereby amended in the manner set out in the second column of the said Schedule: —

The Singapore Telephone Board Act (Chapter 85)	
Section 2	Delete the definition of “financial year” appearing therein.
Section 19	<p>(a) Delete the word “year” appearing in the fifth line thereof and substitute therefor the words “financial year”.</p> <p>(b) Renumber the section as subsection (1), and insert immediately thereafter the following new subsection: —</p> <p>“(2) For the purposes of this section, sections 22(1), 24 and 25 of this Act, “financial year” means a period of twelve months ending on the 31st day of March in any year:</p> <p>Provided that for the year 1972 the financial year shall mean the period between the 1st day of January 1972 and the 31st day of March 1973.”.</p>
The Nanyang University Act (Chapter 178)	
Section 28	<p>(a) Delete the word “April” appearing in the third line thereof and substitute therefor the word “August”.</p> <p>(b) Delete the word “year” appearing in the sixth and in the eighth lines thereof and substitute therefor in each case the words “financial year”.</p> <p>(c) Renumber the section as subsection (1), and insert immediately thereafter the following new subsection: —</p>
