Read the first time on 26th February 1973.

An Act to provide for the issue from the Consolidated Fund of the sums necessary to meet the estimated expenditure for the public services of Singapore for the financial year 1st April, 1973 to 31st March, 1974.

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows: —

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Supply Act, 1973 and shall come into operation on the 1st day of April 1973.

Supply \$1,547,038,440

2. A sum not exceeding one thousand five hundred and forty-seven million, thirtyeight thousand, four hundred and forty dollars is hereby authorised to be issued from the Consolidated Fund for the period from the 1st day of April 1973 to the 31st day of March 1974 and the said sum may be expended as specified in the Schedule to this Act.
