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**Timber Industry Board (Incorporation) Bill**

An Act to provide for the incorporation of the Timber Industry Board as a body corporate, for the purposes of promoting, regulating and improving the timber industry and trade, for the establishment of a Timber Industry Board Fund and for matters connected therewith, and to repeal the Timber Export Industry Board (Incorporation) Act (Chapter 203 of the Revised Edition).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows: —

## PART I

### PRELIMINARY

#### Short title and commencement

1.—(1) This Act may be cited as the Timber Industry Board (Incorporation) Act, 1973 and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may, by notification in the *Gazette*, appoint.

(2) The Minister may appoint different dates for the coming into operation of the different parts or provisions of this Act.

#### Interpretation

2. In this Act, unless the context otherwise requires —

“Board” means the Timber Industry Board established under section 3;

“Chairman” means the Chairman of the Board appointed under subsection (1) of section 4;

“Executive Secretary” means the Executive Secretary of the Board appointed under section 31;

“export”, with its grammatical variations and cognate expressions, means to take or cause to be taken out of Singapore by any means or to place timber in any form of conveyance for the purposes of taking such timber out of Singapore by any means to any place:

Provided that timber taken out of Singapore by the same aircraft or ship by which it was brought into Singapore shall not be deemed to be exported unless after being brought into Singapore the timber has been landed or transhipped within Singapore;
