Parliamentary Pensions (Amendment) Bill

Bill No. 13/1970

Read the first time on 7th May 1970.

An Act to amend the Parliamentary Pensions Act, 1969 (No. 3 of 1969).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows: —

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Parliamentary Pensions (Amendment) Act, 1970, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 1st day of July 1969.

Amendment of long title

2. The long title to the Parliamentary Pensions Act, 1969 (hereinafter in this Act referred to as the “principal Act”) is hereby amended by inserting immediately after the word “Parliament” appearing in the second line thereof the words “or as Speakers”.

Amendment of section 2

3. Section 2 of the principal Act is hereby amended —

- (a) by inserting immediately after the words “Prime Minister” appearing in the third line of the definition of “Member” therein the words “or Speaker”;
- (b) by inserting immediately after the words “Prime Minister” appearing in the third line of the definition of “reckonable service” therein the words “or Speaker”; and
- (c) by inserting immediately after the words “Prime Minister” appearing in the fifth line of the definition of “salary” therein the words “or Speaker”.

Amendment of section 3

4. Subsection (1) of section 3 of the principal Act is hereby amended —

- (a) by deleting the word “ten” appearing in the fourth line thereof and substituting therefor the word “eight”; and
- (b) by deleting the word “fifty” appearing in the last line thereof and substituting therefor the word “forty-five”.

Amendment of section 4

5. Subsection (1) of section 4 of the principal Act is hereby amended —

- (a) by deleting the word “ten” appearing in the first line of paragraph (b) thereof and substituting therefor the word “eight”; and
- (b) by deleting the word “fifty” appearing in the first line of paragraph (c)
