Expenditure of Public Money

Singapore Telephone Board (Amendment) Bill

Bill No. 64/1965

Read the first time on 14th December 1965.

An Act to amend the Singapore Telephone Board Ordinance (*Chapter 107 of the Revised Edition*).

Be it enacted by the President with the advice and consent of the Parliament of Singapore, as follows: —

Short title and commencement

1. This Act may be cited as the Singapore Telephone Board (Amendment) Act, 1965, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on the 9th day of August, 1965.

Amendment of section 2

2. Section 2 of the Singapore Telephone Board Ordinance (hereinafter in this Act referred to as “the Ordinance”) is hereby amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “of the State” appearing at the end of the definition of “public officer” therein; and
- (b) by inserting immediately after the word “Government” appearing in the penultimate line of the definition of “public safety” therein the words “or the Government of Malaysia”.

Amendment of section 5

3. Subsection (1) of section 5 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the word “three” appearing in paragraph (c) thereof and substituting therefor the word “five”.

Amendment of section 15

4. Subsection (1) of section 15 of the Ordinance is hereby amended by deleting the words “of the Federation” appearing immediately after the word “Government” in
