## **Parking Places Ordinance**

### **Bill No. 207/1963**

*Read the first time on 11th June 1963.*

An Ordinance to make provision for parking places and to repeal the existing provisions of the Road Traffic Ordinance, 1961 (*No. 26 of 1961*) relating thereto.

Be it enacted by the Yang di-Pertuan Negara with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Singapore, as follows: —

### **Short title and commencement**

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Parking Places Ordinance, 1963, and shall come into operation on such date as the Minister may by notification in the *Gazette* appoint.

### **Interpretation**

2. In this Ordinance —

“parking place” means any part of a road or any other place on or in which the parking of vehicles is authorised under the provisions of this Ordinance;

“vehicle” means any vehicle whether mechanically propelled or otherwise.

### **Minister may provide parking places**

3. Where it appears to the Minister to be necessary to provide suitable parking places for vehicles, he may provide such parking places in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, and for that purpose may —

(a) utilise any lands which may lawfully be acquired or appropriated for the purpose; or

(b) by order authorise the use as a parking place of any part of a road:

Provided that no such order shall authorise the use of any part of a road so as unreasonably to prevent access to any premises adjoining the road, or the use of the road by any person entitled to the use thereof, or so as to be a nuisance.
