INFECTIOUS DISEASES ACT 1976

INFECTIOUS DISEASES (COVID-19 — STAY ORDERS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2022

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 73 of the Infectious Diseases Act 1976, the Minister for Health makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Infectious Diseases (COVID-19 — Stay Orders) (Amendment) Regulations 2022 and come into operation on 6 January 2022.

Amendment of regulation 2

2. Regulation 2(1) of the Infectious Diseases (COVID-19 — Stay Orders) Regulations 2020 (G.N. No. S 182/2020) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended by deleting the definition of “relevant medical certificate” and substituting the following definitions:

““relevant medical certificate”, for an individual, means a medical certificate issued by a legally qualified medical practitioner (on or after 6 January 2022) —

- (a) certifying that the individual has acute respiratory symptoms and meets the requirements of Protocol 1; and
- (b) excusing the individual from work or school for a period specified in the medical certificate not exceeding 5 days;
