**HEALTH PRODUCTS
(LICENSING OF RETAIL PHARMACIES)
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 72(1) of the Health Products Act, the Health Sciences Authority, with the approval of the Minister for Health, makes the following Regulations:

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations are the Health Products (Licensing of Retail Pharmacies) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2021 and come into operation on 3 January 2022.

Amendment of regulation 2

2. Regulation 2 of the Health Products (Licensing of Retail Pharmacies) Regulations 2016 (G.N. No. S 330/2016) is amended by deleting the definition of “licensed healthcare institution” and substituting the following definition:

““licensed healthcare institution” means —

- (a) any premises or conveyance specified in a licence granted under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 for the provision of any licensable healthcare service; or
- (b) a healthcare institution that is licensed under the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act 1980;”.
