**MEDICINES  
(ADVERTISEMENTS BY HEALTHCARE INSTITUTIONS)  
(EXEMPTION) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 51(4)(b) of the Medicines Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Medicines (Advertisements by Healthcare Institutions) (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2021 and comes into operation on 3 January 2022.

**Deletion and substitution of paragraph 2**

2. Paragraph 2 of the Medicines (Advertisements by Healthcare Institutions) (Exemption) Order 2004 (G.N. No. S 279/2004) is deleted and the following paragraph substituted therefor:

**“Exemption from section 51(1)(b) of Act**

2. Section 51(1)(b) of the Act does not apply in relation to any advertisement published or caused to be published by —

- (a) a person who is licensed under the Healthcare Services Act 2020 to provide any licensable healthcare service; or
- (b) a person who holds a licence for a healthcare institution under the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Act 1980.”.
