### **CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE**

#### **PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION (DELEGATION OF DISCIPLINARY FUNCTIONS) (AMENDMENT) DIRECTIONS 2021**

In exercise of the powers conferred by Article 116(3) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, the Public Service Commission makes the following Directions:

#### **Citation and commencement**

**1.** These Directions are the Public Service Commission (Delegation of Disciplinary Functions) (Amendment) Directions 2021 and come into operation on 15 April 2021.

#### **Amendment of direction 2**

**2.** Direction 2 of the Public Service Commission (Delegation of Disciplinary Functions) Directions (Dir 1) is amended by deleting the definition of “Permanent Secretary” and substituting the following definition:

““Permanent Secretary” includes —

- (a) the Solicitor-General;
- (b) the Chief Executive, Attorney-General’s Chambers;
- (c) the Auditor-General;
- (d) the Clerk of Parliament;
- (e) the Secretary to the Public Service Commission;
- (f) the Chief Executive, Office of the Chief Justice;
- (g) the Principal Private Secretary to the President;
- (h) the Secretary to the Prime Minister;
