In exercise of the powers conferred by section 66 of the Active Mobility Act 2017, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and period in force

1.—(1) This Order is the Active Mobility (Jurong Lake Gardens Trial — Exemption) Order 2020.

(2) This Order is in force for one year starting 10 January 2020.

Definitions

2. In this Order —

“buggy” means an electronically operated four-wheeled lightweight vehicle intended for short distance commuting;

“National Parks Board” means the National Parks Board established by the repealed National Parks Act (Cap. 198A, 1991 Ed.) in force before 1 July 1996 and continued by section 3 of the National Parks Board Act (Cap. 198A);
