**HUMAN BIOMEDICAL RESEARCH ACT 2015  
(AMENDMENT OF FIFTH SCHEDULE)  
ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 62 of the Human Biomedical Research Act 2015, the Minister for Health makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order is the Human Biomedical Research Act 2015 (Amendment of Fifth Schedule) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 November 2019.

**Amendment of Fifth Schedule**

2. Paragraph 4 of the Fifth Schedule to the Human Biomedical Research Act 2015 is amended by deleting sub-paragraph (*h*) and substituting the following sub-paragraph:

“(h) provision is made for any person as follows, or combination of such persons, to certify to the best of that person’s or combination of persons’ knowledge that sub-paragraphs (*a*) and (*e*) have been complied with:

- (i) a medical practitioner who is registered under the Medical Registration Act (Cap. 174) as a specialist in the specialty relating to the research and who is not involved in the research as a researcher or supervisor;
- (ii) a person approved by the Director by name, or holding the office or designation or falling within the description approved by the Director.”.
