**IMMIGRATION
(EXEMPTION FROM SINGAPORE VISA)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 56 of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Immigration (Exemption from Singapore Visa) (Amendment) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 22 January 2019.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. Paragraph 2 of the Immigration (Exemption from Singapore Visa) Order (O 4) is amended by inserting, immediately after sub-paragraph (1A), the following sub-paragraph:

“(1B) Section 9B(1) of the Act does not apply to a non-citizen who arrives in Singapore (by air, sea or land) from a place outside Singapore —

(a) who —

- (i) holds a valid diplomatic, official or service passport issued by the government of the Republic of Kazakhstan; and
- (ii) is travelling to Singapore for an attendance not exceeding 30 days;
