**MEDICINES
(TRADITIONAL MEDICINES, HOMOEOPATHIC
MEDICINES AND OTHER SUBSTANCES) (EXEMPTION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 9 of the Medicines Act, the Minister for Health makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Medicines (Traditional Medicines, Homoeopathic Medicines and other Substances) (Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 January 2020.

Amendment of paragraph 3

2. The Medicines (Traditional Medicines, Homoeopathic Medicines and other Substances) (Exemption) Order (O 6) is amended by renumbering paragraph 3 as sub-paragraph (1) of that paragraph, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following sub-paragraph:

“(2) Sections 5 and 6 of the Act do not apply to a person in respect of that person selling, offering for sale, supplying, exporting, importing, manufacturing, assembling, or selling or offering for sale by way of wholesale dealing any topical antiseptic that does not contain mercury or any compound of mercury.”.
