**PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS ACT
(AMENDMENT OF SECOND SCHEDULE)
ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 42(8) of the Parliamentary Elections Act, the Prime Minister makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Parliamentary Elections Act (Amendment of Second Schedule) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 April 2019.

Deletion and substitution of Second Schedule

2. The Second Schedule to the Parliamentary Elections Act is deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor:

DIRECTIONS FOR GUIDANCE OF VOTERS

1. When you are given a ballot paper, go to a polling booth.
2. Mark on your ballot paper an “X” in the empty box for the candidate, or the group of candidates (in the case of a group representation constituency), you are voting for.
 - (a) Do not make any other mark on your ballot paper, or your vote may not be counted.
 - (b) If you make a mistake when marking your ballot paper, return it to the presiding officer and ask for another ballot paper.
