REGISTRATION OF CRIMINALS ACT
(AMENDMENT OF THIRD SCHEDULE)
ORDER 2019

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the Registration of Criminals Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Registration of Criminals Act (Amendment of Third Schedule) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 1 January 2020.

Amendment of Third Schedule

2. The Third Schedule to the Registration of Criminals Act is amended —

- (a) by deleting the item relating to “Unnatural offences” in Part I;
- (b) by inserting, immediately after Part IA, the following Part:

“PART IBOFFENCES UNDER THE PENAL CODE INCLUDED
WITH EFFECT FROM 1 JANUARY 2020

Punishment for murder (imprisonment for life)	Section 302(2) (Cap. 224 of the 2008 Ed.)
Causing death of child below 14 years of age, domestic worker or vulnerable person by sustained abuse	Section 304B
Causing or allowing death of child below 14 years of age, domestic worker or vulnerable person in same household	Section 304C
Attempt to commit culpable homicide	Section 308
Causing death in furtherance of group’s object	Section 308A
Punishment for voluntarily causing hurt which causes grievous hurt	Section 323A
Voluntarily causing grievous hurt to extort property, or to constrain to an illegal act	Section 329
Voluntarily causing grievous hurt to extort confession or to compel restoration of property	Section 331
Voluntarily causing grievous hurt to deter public servant from his duty	Section 333
Kidnapping or abducting in order to subject a person to grievous hurt, slavery, etc.	Section 367
