**SUPREME COURT OF JUDICATURE ACT  
(AMENDMENT OF FIFTH SCHEDULE)  
ORDER 2019**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 83(1) of the Supreme Court of Judicature Act, the Minister for Law, after consulting the Chief Justice, makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

**1.** This Order is the Supreme Court of Judicature Act (Amendment of Fifth Schedule) Order 2019 and comes into operation on 2 October 2019.

**Amendment of Fifth Schedule**

**2.** Paragraph 1 of the Fifth Schedule to the Supreme Court of Judicature Act is amended by deleting the full-stop at the end of sub-paragraph (i) and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following sub-paragraph:

“(j) where a Judge at the hearing of an appeal under section 17, 29, 35 or 44 of the Protection from Online Falsehoods and Manipulation Act 2019 (Act 18 of 2019) refuses to set aside the Part 3 Direction, Part 4 Direction, Declaration or Account Restriction Direction (as the case may be) against which the appeal was brought.”.
