ADMINISTRATION OF MUSLIM LAW ACT (CHAPTER 3)

ADMINISTRATION OF MUSLIM LAW (HALAL CERTIFICATES) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 88C of the Administration of Muslim Law Act, the Majlis Ugama Islam, Singapura, with the approval of Dr Yaacob Ibrahim, who is charged with the responsibility for the portfolio of the Minister for Culture, Community and Youth as regards Muslim affairs, makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Administration of Muslim Law (Halal Certificates) (Amendment) Rules 2018 and come into operation on 1 February 2018.

Deletion and substitution of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Administration of Muslim Law (Halal Certificates) Rules (R 8) is deleted and the following Schedule substituted therefor:

(c) exceeding 750 square metres but not exceeding 2,000 square metres	\$980
(d) exceeding 2,000 square metres	\$1,975
5. Halal certificate with a validity period of one year to operate any of the following retail food establishments:	
(a) a restaurant with a total floor area not exceeding 186 square metres	\$775
(b) a restaurant with a total floor area exceeding 186 square metres	\$1,140
(c) a food or hawker stall, or any stall selling uncooked food, with a total floor area not exceeding 13 square metres	\$350
(d) a food or hawker stall, or any stall selling uncooked food, with a	\$565
