CONSTITUTION OF THE REPUBLIC OF SINGAPORE (RESPONSIBILITY FOR THE PORTFOLIO OF THE PRIME MINISTER) (NO. 4) NOTIFICATION 2018

Responsibility for Portfolio of Prime Minister

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, directed that with effect from 7 August 2018, Mr S Iswaran is charged with the responsibility for the portfolio of the Prime Minister insofar as the responsibility relates to cybersecurity.

Delegated Responsibility

2. It is further notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, directed that with effect from 7 August 2018, Dr Janil Puthucheary, Senior Minister of State, Ministry of Communications and Information, is charged with the responsibility of assisting Mr S Iswaran on cybersecurity.
