CONSUMER PROTECTION (SAFETY REQUIREMENTS)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2) REGULATIONS 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 11 and 32 of the Consumer Protection (Trade Descriptions and Safety Requirements) Act, the Minister for Trade and Industry makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2018 and come into operation on 11 October 2018.

**Amendment of regulation 2**

2. Regulation 2(1) of the Consumer Protection (Safety Requirements) Regulations (Rg 1) (called in these Regulations the principal Regulations) is amended —

- (a) by deleting the words “regulation 7 of the Standards, Productivity and Innovation Board (Conformity Assessment) Regulations (Cap. 303A, Rg 2)” in the definition of “CAB (Certification)” and substituting the words “the Enterprise Singapore Board (Conformity Assessment) Regulations 2018 (G.N. No. S 686/2018)”;
- (b) by deleting the words “regulation 7 of the Standards, Productivity and Innovation Board (Conformity Assessment) Regulations” in the definition of “CAB (Testing)” and substituting the words “the Enterprise Singapore Board (Conformity Assessment) Regulations 2018”;
