### **HEALTH PRODUCTS ACT (CHAPTER 122D)**

#### **HEALTH PRODUCTS (LICENSING OF RETAIL PHARMACIES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 72 of the Health Products Act, the Health Sciences Authority, with the approval of the Minister for Health, makes the following Regulations:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Health Products (Licensing of Retail Pharmacies) (Amendment) Regulations 2018 and come into operation on 1 March 2018.

#### **Amendment of regulation 2**

2. Regulation 2 of the Health Products (Licensing of Retail Pharmacies) Regulations 2016 (G.N. No. S 330/2016) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after the definition of “Authority’s website”, the following definition:

““collaborative prescribing practitioner” has the same meaning as in regulation 56C(6) of the Private Hospitals and Medical Clinics Regulations (Cap. 248, Rg 1);”;

(b) by deleting paragraph (a) of the definition of “dispense” and substituting the following paragraph:

“(a) a qualified practitioner or collaborative prescribing practitioner, or a person acting under the supervision of a qualified practitioner or collaborative prescribing practitioner; or”; and
