PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS ACT (CHAPTER 253)

PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERS (AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2018

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 36 of the Professional Engineers Act, the Professional Engineers Board, with the approval of the Minister for National Development, makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Professional Engineers (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2018 and come into operation on 20 August 2018.

Amendment of Fourth Schedule

2. The Fourth Schedule to the Professional Engineers Rules (R 1) is amended by deleting item 7 and substituting the following item:

"	7. Protective security engineering	(a) Civil or Mechanical	The applicant is required to satisfy any of the following sets of conditions:
	engineering		sets of conditions: Set (A) (i) the applicant has not less than 4 years (in aggregate) of such experience in protective security engineering (whether in Singapore or elsewhere) as may be acceptable to the Board, of which at least 3 years of that
			experience was obtained whilst

- practising as a registered professional engineer in Singapore; and
- (ii) the applicant has a post-graduate degree (such as M.Sc or PhD) majoring in protective security engineering as may be acceptable to the Board;

Set (B)

- (i) the applicant has not less than 5 years (in aggregate) of such experience in protective security engineering (whether Singapore elsewhere) as may be acceptable to the Board, of which at least 3 years of that experience was obtained whilst practising as registered professional engineer in Singapore;
- (ii) the applicant has successfully completed a training course in protective security engineering specified by the Board; and
- (iii) the applicant has passed a specialist registration examination on protective security engineering conducted by the Board;
