### **ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)**

#### **ROAD TRAFFIC (INTERNATIONAL CIRCULATION) (AMENDMENT NO. 2) RULES 2018**

In exercise of the powers conferred by sections 25 and 34 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (International Circulation) (Amendment No. 2) Rules 2018 and come into operation on 26 November 2018.

#### **Amendment of rule 2**

2. Rule 2(1) of the Road Traffic (International Circulation) Rules (R 7) (called in these Rules the principal Rules) is amended by inserting, immediately after the word “rule” in the definition of “vehicle entry card”, “18A,”.

#### **New rule 18A**

3. The principal Rules are amended by inserting, immediately after rule 18, the following rule:

##### **“Application for vehicle entry card by electronic service**

**18A.—**(1) A person who intends to bring a vehicle into Singapore by way of a relevant checkpoint may, before arriving at the relevant checkpoint, apply for a vehicle entry card in relation to the vehicle by using the electronic service the Authority provides.

(2) An application under paragraph (1) must be accompanied by the information and documents that the Registrar requires.
