**Variation of Responsibility of Minister for Communications  
and Information**

It is notified for general information that the Prime Minister has, under Article 30(1) of the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore, varied with effect from 1 May 2017, the Schedule to the Constitution of the Republic of Singapore (Responsibility of the Minister for Communications and Information) Notification 2015 (G.N. No. S 664/2015) —

- (a) by deleting item 1 under the heading “DEPARTMENTS AND STATUTORY BODIES”; and
- (b) by deleting the words “Public Sector IT Services and Security” in item 5 under the heading “SUBJECTS”.
