**PUBLIC ORDER ACT  
(CHAPTER 257A)**

**PUBLIC ORDER (ELECTION MEETINGS  
IN PARLIAMENTARY ELECTIONS)  
(AMENDMENT NO. 2)  
REGULATIONS 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 47 of the Public Order Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations are the Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) (Amendment No. 2) Regulations 2017 and come into operation on 1 October 2017.

**Amendment of regulation 3**

2. Regulation 3 of the Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 (G.N. No. S 486/2009) is amended by deleting the full-stop at the end of the definition of “polling day” and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following definition:

““special notice” means the special notice of intention to organise an event, required by section 6A of the Act.”.

**New regulation 11**

3. The Public Order (Election Meetings in Parliamentary Elections) Regulations 2009 are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 10, the following regulation:

**“Special notice of election meeting**

**11.—**(1) For the purposes of section 6A(1) of the Act, special notice of an election meeting must be given to the Commissioner
