### ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

#### ROAD TRAFFIC (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 135(2) of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

#### **Citation and commencement**

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Composition of Offences) (Amendment) Rules 2017 and come into operation on 15 February 2017.

#### **New rule 2A**

2. The Road Traffic (Composition of Offences) Rules (R 29) are amended by inserting, immediately after rule 2, the following rule:

##### **“Conditions to compound certain offences**

**2A.**—(1) Despite rule 2, a specified offence may not be compounded by a person mentioned in that rule unless the Authority has received payment of the arrears stated in the offer of composition for the specified offence.

(2) In this rule —

“arrears”, in relation to an offer of composition for a specified offence committed in respect of a motor vehicle, means the following amounts:

- (a) any unpaid vehicle entry fee under rule 20E(1) of the Road Traffic (International Circulation) Rules (R 7) incurred in respect of the last entry of the motor vehicle into Singapore;
