ROAD TRAFFIC ACT (CHAPTER 276)

ROAD TRAFFIC (COMPOSITION OF OFFENCES) (AMENDMENT) RULES 2017

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 135(2) of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Composition of Offences) (Amendment) Rules 2017 and come into operation on 15 February 2017.

New rule 2A

2. The Road Traffic (Composition of Offences) Rules (R 29) are amended by inserting, immediately after rule 2, the following rule:

"Conditions to compound certain offences

2A.—(1) Despite rule 2, a specified offence may not be compounded by a person mentioned in that rule unless the Authority has received payment of the arrears stated in the offer of composition for the specified offence.

(2) In this rule —

- "arrears", in relation to an offer of composition for a specified offence committed in respect of a motor vehicle, means the following amounts:
 - (a) any unpaid vehicle entry fee under rule 20E(1) of the Road Traffic (International Circulation) Rules (R 7) incurred in respect of the last entry of the motor vehicle into Singapore;
