**ROAD TRAFFIC ACT
(CHAPTER 276)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC (EXPRESSWAY TRAFFIC)
(AMENDMENT) RULES 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 114(1) of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Rules:

Citation and commencement

1. These Rules are the Road Traffic (Expressway Traffic) (Amendment) Rules 2017 and come into operation on 2 May 2017.

Amendment of rule 13

2. Rule 13 of the Road Traffic (Expressway Traffic) Rules (R 23) (called in these Rules the principal Rules) is amended by inserting, immediately after the words “General restrictions” in the rule heading, the words “in relation to conduct”.

Amendment of rule 14

3. Rule 14 of the principal Rules is amended —

- (a) by inserting, immediately before the words “a vehicle” in paragraph (1)(f), the words “subject to rule 14B(a),”;
- (b) by deleting the word “and” at the end of paragraph (1)(i);
- (c) by deleting the full-stop at the end of sub-paragraph (j) of paragraph (1) and substituting a semi-colon, and by inserting immediately thereafter the following sub-paragraphs:
 - “(k) any vehicle that has pedals and is built to be propelled solely by human power, including a bicycle, tricycle or trishaw;
