**ROAD TRAFFIC ACT
(CHAPTER 276)**

**ROAD TRAFFIC
(QUOTA SYSTEM — EXEMPTION)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2017**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 142 of the Road Traffic Act, the Minister for Transport makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Road Traffic (Quota System — Exemption) (Amendment) Order 2017 and comes into operation on 18 December 2017.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. Paragraph 2 of the Road Traffic (Quota System — Exemption) Order (O 5) (called in this Order the principal Order) is amended —

- (a) by deleting the definitions of “community bus service”, “courtesy bus service” and “tourist bus service”; and
- (b) by deleting the definition of “regular route service” and substituting the following definition:

“ “regular route service” has the same meaning as in section 2 of the Bus Services Industry Act 2015 (Act 30 of 2015);”.

Amendment of paragraph 3

3. Paragraph 3 of the principal Order is amended by deleting the words “SBS Transit Ltd., SMRT Buses Ltd. or” in sub-paragraph (a).
