IMMIGRATION
(EXEMPTION FROM SINGAPORE VISA)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2016

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 56 of the Immigration Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order is the Immigration (Exemption from Singapore Visa) (Amendment) Order 2016 and comes into operation on 1 March 2016.

Amendment of paragraph 2

2. Paragraph 2 of the Immigration (Exemption from Singapore Visa) Order (O 4) is amended —

(a) by inserting, immediately after sub-paragraph (ge) of sub-paragraph (1), the following sub-paragraph:

“(gf) a non-citizen —

(i) who —

(A) is a person appointed to work in a diplomatic mission or consular office of the government of the foreign territory specified in Part X of the Schedule; and

(B) holds a valid diplomatic, official or service passport issued by the government of that foreign territory;
