**ENERGY CONSERVATION ACT
(CHAPTER 92C)**

**ENERGY CONSERVATION (REGISTRABLE GOODS)
(AMENDMENT) ORDER 2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Energy Conservation Act, the Minister for the Environment and Water Resources, after consultation with the National Environment Agency, makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Energy Conservation (Registrable Goods) (Amendment) Order 2015 and comes into operation on 1 July 2015.

Amendment of Schedule

2. The Schedule to the Energy Conservation (Registrable Goods) Order 2013 (G.N. No. S 556/2013) is amended by inserting, immediately after Part II, the following Part:

“PART III

**REGISTRABLE GOODS
WITH EFFECT FROM 1 JULY 2015**

1. Subject to paragraph 2, single-phase lamp (not being second-hand goods) with Edison screw or bayonet lamp cap that is designed to be connected directly to 230 volts mains voltage by means of a socket or lamp connector, having a power rating —

- (a) in the case of an incandescent lamp, of 25 W or above but not exceeding 200 W;
- (b) in the case of a compact fluorescent lamp with integrated ballast, of up to 60 W; or
- (c) in the case of an LED lamp, of up to 60 W.
