**POLICE FORCE ACT  
(CHAPTER 235)**

**POLICE (SPECIAL CONSTABULARY)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2015**

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 85 of the Police Force Act, the Minister for Home Affairs makes the following Regulations:

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police (Special Constabulary) (Amendment) Regulations 2015 and come into operation on 1 June 2015.

**Amendment of regulation 3**

2. Regulation 3(1) of the Police (Special Constabulary) Regulations (Rg 3) is amended by deleting the words “section 68” in sub-paragraphs (a) and (b) and substituting in each case the words “section 68(1)”.

**New regulation 6A**

3. The Police (Special Constabulary) Regulations are amended by inserting, immediately after regulation 6, the following regulation:

**“Medical examination for volunteer, etc.**

**6A.—**(1) Every person who enrolls or is enrolled as a volunteer under section 68(1) of the Act must undergo a medical examination if so required by the Commander, Volunteer Special Constabulary.

(2) Every person who enrolls or is enrolled as a volunteer ex-NSman under section 68(2A) of the Act must undergo a medical examination if so required by the Director, Police National Service Department.”.
